Quick Response Program (QRP)

Because patients are being discharged from hospital earlier than ever before, we have developed the Quick Response Program (QRP). It is designed to get in place the equipment, therapy and supports you urgently need to safely go home. You can expect that:

- within 1 or 2 days, your QRP coordinator (who may be a Case Manager, Occupational Therapist or a Social Worker) will contact you and the hospital to identify your needs
- within 2 or 3 days, urgent equipment and services will be delivered to your home.

Your QRP coordinator will also work with you and your hospital team to:

- develop a comprehensive discharge plan, including what services and supports you will require in your ongoing recovery
- help you choose the best providers
- handle the necessary reporting and funding approvals from your insurer.
